All Club Representative/Contacts from last year or next year are welcome to attend this meeting and vote on any matters under discussion.

Directions: If approaching from Truro on Route 102, veer left onto Route 118, and exit onto Route 111 going south (after passing underneath it). If approaching from the Valley on Route 101, take exit 1 to Dartmouth, veer left onto Victoria Road just beyond Burnside, and then turn onto the 111 going east (after crossing over it). If approaching Halifax from the South Shore follow the signs to the MacKay Bridge to pick up Route 111. Follow 111 to its end and turn right onto Pleasant Street. Go about 1.3 km to find the three entrances to North Woodside Community Centre on the left (harbour side).
