Erratum: New Brunswick Endomychidae (Coleoptera)

Majka (2007) newly recorded the endomychid beetle, *Rhanidea unicolor* (Ziegler, 1845), for the province of New Brunswick, Canada on the basis of a specimen collected in Charters Settlement, York County on 15 June 2002 by R.P. Webster.

This determination was in error, and the individual is actually a specimen of *Lycoperdina ferruginea* LeConte, 1824, a species newly recorded from New Brunswick, but previously recorded from the neighbouring provinces of Nova Scotia (Majka 2007) and Québec (Laplante *et al.* 1991). *Lycoperdina ferruginea* feeds on puffball fungi (Lycoperdales) (Pakaluk 1984) although Shockley *et al.* (2009) also reported this species from fungi in the Hydnaceae (Cantharellales), Pezizaceae (Pezizales), and Pluteaceae (Agaricales).
