

## **Nationals FAQ**

### Stage Drawings and Descriptions

- Will be published on the website July 1, 2009

### Round Count

- Published May 1 for Pistol, Rifle and Shotgun.

### Awards Recognition:

- Awards will be presented based on the participation in the divisions, categories and classes as of registration cut-off, July 1. There is a minimum of 10 participants for each division, and a minimum of 5 participants for each category and class.
- Divisions (planned): Open, Standard, Production, Revolver
- Categories(planned): Lady, Junior, Senior and Super Senior
- ICS Classes(planned): GM, M, A, B, C, D
- Note that if you feel your ICS Class is too low to represent your ability, you can request to be put in a higher class.

### Registration Confirmation:

- We will email you confirmation that we have received your registration within 2 days of receipt of the entry form and payment.

### Membership requirement:

- You must be a member in good standing of IPSC Canada through your appropriate section to participate.

### Foreign Competitors:

### Match Ammunition:

- We have two suppliers, one for the pistol portion and one for the rifle and shotgun portion. In both cases, your ammunition will be waiting for you at the range when you arrive.
- Pistol Match Ammunition will be supplied by Wolf Bullets [www.wolfbullets.com](http://www.wolfbullets.com) - 9mm 125gr Minor, 40S&W 180gr Major - two lengths; standard and 2011 frame length, 38 Supercomp Major, 45ACP 230gr Major.
- Rifle (223) and Shotgun Ammunition (12 gauge slug and shot) will be supplied by CRAFTM. <http://www.crafm.com/>
- Orders must be placed by July 1 in order to be shipped to the competition in time.
- Please make direct arrangements with the supplier to place your order.
