Student Science Writing Competition 2012

The Nova Scotian Institute of Science (NSIS), in collaboration with the Situating Science Knowledge Cluster (Halifax), is sponsoring the NSIS 2012 Science Writing Competition. There are two categories of entries: one is the preparation of a written article by a graduate student; the other is the preparation of a paper by an undergraduate.

As the NSIS is celebrating its 150th Anniversary in 2012, the Competition Committee is encouraging submissions of papers as the winners will be given special recognition .

Prizes will be awarded in two categories:
**\$500 for the best article written by a
Graduate**
**\$250 for the best article written by an
Undergraduate**

The work of the winners will be featured on the NSIS and Situating Science Knowledge Cluster websites. The author of the winning paper will also be invited to submit the paper for publication in the *Proceedings of the Nova Scotian Institute of Science*.

The competition is open to students currently enrolled
in a Nova Scotia University.
