Format: One round of pools, followed by direct elimination for all fencers. All events will be run mixed men and women.

Entry Fee: \$20.00 for first event, \$15.00 for each subsequent event
Registrar must receive notification of intent to compete on or before **Tuesday, January 3rd, 2012**. Please include name, date of birth, CFF #, Club, and desired events. Should pre-registration in an event be fewer than 6, the organizers reserve the right to cancel the event. Those already pre-registered will be notified by email.

Fees are due a check-in. Please make cheques payable to Dalhousie Fencing Club

Equipment: Non-FIE jackets require a plastron, masks are required to pass a 12kg punch test, foil will be fenced with a non-electric mask, gloves must cover approximately half the forearm, pants must cover to at least below the knees and be of a suitably sturdy material, and knee-high socks must be worn with fencing breeches.

Membership: All participants must have a validated CFF license for the current season, as well as an active provincial membership (such as from FANS). **PLEASE ENSURE YOUR LICENCE IS RENEWED.**

Canteen: As of right now, there is no canteen service on-site. There is a Subway, Tim Horton's, a few pizza places, a Second Cup, &c. within walking distance. If Dalhousie does decide to open the lunch vendor cart for the tournament, registrants will be notified by email.

Directions: Studley gym is on the main campus of Dalhousie, at the northernmost terminus of University Ave. and directly across the avenue from the Killam library.

Accommodations: As the tournament is held in downtown Halifax, there should no problem finding an available hotel or bed-and-breakfast.

Prizes awarded to the top four fencers in any event. Points are determined based on final placement in that event.
