General Tournament Rules:

- Open to all belts and age levels.
- All competitors must be registered members in good standing of their governing association (proof of membership may be required).
- Competitors must be in good health and complete tournament registration and waiver form for each category registered.
- Weigh-ins are during posted times ONLY and late arrivals WILL NOT be accepted.
- IJF Rules will apply except where modified by the Tournament Committee.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine or sub-divide categories if warranted but will consult with coaches (or parents) of any affected competitors.
- The 'Golden Match' method will be utilized to determine a winner of a 'tie' match at the end of the regulation time.
- Cadets and older may compete in one 'additional' category, the 2nd must be in the next older age category. Senior competitors may compete in an Open category.
- To register for a 2nd category, the main registration form must be completed as well as the "Second Category Registration Form" with appropriate approvals (see attached forms).
- If registration numbers warrant, there will be a Masters Category for persons 35 years of age or older on the date of the Tournament. A Judoka cannot compete in both the Senior Category and Masters Category.
- Match Length unless decided otherwise, duration of judo matches shall be as follows:

Tykes and Atoms 2 minutes
Pee Wees and Cadets 3 minutes
Juveniles and IJF Juniors 4 minutes
All Senior Divisions 5 minutes
Masters 3 minutes

- Competitors must be prepared (dressed and warmed up) for their category with minimal notice. Division matches will not be rescheduled due to the lack of availability of a competitor (with the exception of a Judoka competing in a division that is already open on the floor).
- Three regulation mat areas will be used.
- Blue Judogi is optional.

Masters Competition: Only if registration numbers warrant.
