

**NEW LOCATION**: Saturday Workshops: Nova Scotia Community College, Stellarton Campus Directions Heading East: Take Exit 24 at New Glasgow and turn LEFT at the Stop sign at the end of the interchange (across from Heather Motel). Directions Heading West: Take Exit 24 and bear RIGHT, under the underpass, past Heather Motel.

# FUN NIGHT AND COMMUNITY DANCE IDEAS from CALLERLAB

#### SOUND OFF SQUARE

Music: (try a March)

Couples 1 and 3 Circle left (8), then reverse to right (8), All Swing partner (8), Ladies to the Centre, Men walk around to right (8), Swing your own (8),

Reach into the middle and clap 4 times starting with hands low and rising, Allemande Left (8) Grand Right and Left full around (16)

Repeat for Couples 2 and 4 with Ladies to the Centre Repeat for Couples 1 and 3 with Gents to the Centre Repeat for Couples 2 and 4 with Gents to the Centre

#### LADY ROUND THE LADY TRADITIONAL SQUARE

Music: Swanee River, Lloyd Shaw 521/522

Couple # 1 Lead to the right, Lady go round the lady, Gent go round the gent (lady lead between) Gent go round the lady and lady go round the gent (lady lead again between #2)

Circle 4 half way round, #1 duck right thru,

Swing your lady round in the middle and take her on with you

Variations in cueing: She go round She, He go round He; Ma go round Ma, Pa go round Pa

# FUN NIGHT AND COMMUNITY DANCE IDEAS from CALLERLAB

## **APPALACHIAN BASKET for 5 or 6 couples**

Music: (Something with good buzz step group swing potential)

1-16 Allemande Left

Turn Partner Right full around, men into a star Balance away from partner and toward partner

17-32 Men Star Left, Girls walk forward

Swing Partner ending with men facing in, Men join hands and arch

33-48 Lady go round behind her partner, then under arch to the left of her partner Around man to her left and out under arch

Around another man and in under arch

Ladies circle left in the middle passing one more man

49-64 Ladies continue to hold hands and back out through arch, Men drop hands inside Buzz step to the left (right foot in towards centre, left foot behind)

# ONE LINE GO UP AND BACK

Setup: Normal Square

Couples #1 go down the middle and split 2 around 1 to a line One line go up and back

Same four go forward, separate in couples around 1 and into the middle of a line

Possible Get Outs: Square Thru 3, Allemande Left

or Ladies Chain over and Back, Circle Left, Allemande Left, Pass One, Swing

#### **NINE PIN**

Setup: Normal Square with an extra lady or man in the middle

Use Circle Choreo for the outside

Circle Left, Allemande Left, Grand Right and Left etc

Sample choreo using the Nine Pin

Nine Pin turn man # 1 by the right and man # 3 by the left

Nine Pin Dosado lady # 2 and lady # 3

Then 5 Ladies or Men Circle left in the middle, Swing (lady or man leftover is new Nine Pin)

# **WIND AND WEAVE:**

Setup: Four couples promenade toward Caller into line, face and back away.

Dosado, Left Dosado, Turn by Right Elbow, Turn by Left Elbow,
Lady # 1 U Turn Back, Man #1 chase her in Wind and Weave pattern
(around Lady # 2, across between Man # 2 & # 3, around man # 3 and
back across between lady # 3 & # 4, then around to the end)
Same two Circle Left Half ending with lady on lady's side and man on men's side.
Repeat for all ladies then repeat for all men (adjust the weave pattern).

# FUN NIGHT AND COMMUNITY DANCE IDEAS from CALLERLAB

#### **VENUS AND MARS STARS**

Setup: Normal Square

Version 1:

Couple # 1 California Twirl

Couple # 2 Wheel in behind then # 3 then # 4

Gents Star Left, Ladies Star Right

Gents Step in behind your date, Walk Single File and don't be late

Lady # 1 lead ladies out to a Left-hand star, Gents keep going with a Right-hand star

Ladies step in behind your man, It's single file around again

Ladies step out and Back Track once around, Pass Partner,

Allemande Left, Grand Right and Left

Version 2:

Couple #1 Bow and Swing then Promenade inside the ring

When you're home face the Caller

Couple # 4 Wheel in behind, then Couple # 3 and finally Couple # 2 is last

Gents Star Left, Ladies Star Right, Turn the Stars twice tonight

Gents Step in behind your date, Walk Single File and don't be late

Gent #1 lead men out to a left-hand star, Ladies keep going where you are

Ladies Step in behind your man, it's single file around again

Gents turn in, skip your date, Allemande Left with corner mate

Swing your own and Promenade eight

#### KINGSTON FLYER

Setup: 6 couples with Ladies on caller's left and men on caller's right

Note: in order to complete the lead around, dancers must step out briskly with big steps.

- 1-16 Lady number 1 lead ladies around the men (16 steps so move it out)
- 17-32 Man number 1 lead men around the ladies (16 steps)
- 33-48 Couple number 1 sashay down and sashay back (8 down, 8 back)
- 49-56 Couple number 1 separate around to the foot of each line
- 57-64 Couple number 1 two hand turn once around

## **JEFFERSON AND LIBERTY CONTRA:**

Setup: Proper contra with ladies on caller's left and men on caller's right Sort into groups of 4, couple #1 at top and #2 below in each group

Circle Left (8), Circle Right (8), Star Right (8), Star Left (8)

#1's Go Down Outside own line (8 steps), Return to place (8 steps).

Go around one to a line of 4, Lines go Down (8), Lines Back Up (4),

Arch in the middle and Ends Duck Through and on to new groups of four (4)

When a couple has no one to dance with: turn around individually, rest one sequence, then switch numbers and start back the other way.

# **SUMMERTIME DREAM PRIMER CONTRA** by Jerry Helt

Setup: Alternate Duple (Couples 1, 3 and 5 crossed over)

Music: Summertime Dream, Chaparral

- 1-8 Ladies into the centre march down 8,
- 9-16 Turn and come back 8
- 17-24 Men into the centre and march down 8
- 25-32 Turn and come back 8
- 33-40 With partner march down 8
- 41-48 Turn alone and come back 8
- 49-56 Face partner, Pass Thru and Turn Alone
- 56-64 Men with lady on right Half Promenade

## FOUR CORNERS WALTZ LINE DANCE

Music: Last Cheater's Waltz

All start with left foot,

Cross 2, 3; Cross 2, 3 (two Twinkles)

Repeat two Twinkles;;

Forward Waltz Box;;

Balance Left and Right;;

Forward, 2, 3; Back and turn 2, 3; (towards left front corner, turning to left)

Forward, 2, 3; Back and turn 2, 3: (towards left back corner, turning to left)

Forward, 2, 3; Back and turn 2, 3; (towards right back corner, turning to left)

Forward, 2, 3; Back and turn 2, 3: (towards right front corner, turning to face front)

#### LIGHTED SCONCE CIRCLE MIXER

Music: New Lloyd Shaw CD with Hammered Dulcimer

- 1-8 Circle Left
- 9-16 Lasso Girl around her partner
- 17-24 Circle Right
- 25-32 Lasso Girl around partner and a bit more to end girl in front of man
- 33-40 Push into Centre (4), Back out (4)
- 41-48 Dosado and go to the person on your left
- 49-56 Push into Centre (4), Back out (4)
- 57-64 Same two Circle left once around and put lady on the right
