

CALLERLAB UPDATE

NEW YOUTH MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY: A person who is less than 21 years old may apply to be a Youth Member. There were 3 callers present at the meeting who Were less than 21 and one who is 25. The new membership category is intended to encourage more young callers to become fully participating members. Having established the category it will be possible to offer some reduction in membership cost.

MAINSTREAM TEACHING ORDER: Agreement was reached on a proposed revision to the Mainstream Teaching Order. This now goes out to all members of the Ad-Hoc Subcommittee for their approval to recommend to the Mainstream committee that it be used on a trial basis during next year. CIRCLE IDEAS FROM TRADITIONAL SQUARES

Formation: Square (although much of this could also be danced in a big circle)

Allemande Left your corner, then you walk right by your own A right arm round the right-hand girl, & a left arm round your own All the Gents Star Right in the middle, all the way around Then Allemande Left your corner, partner right go Right and Left Grand

Allemande Left your corner, Turn partner by the right full around to the next Turn your Right-Hand Lady by the left arm, Come home to Swing and Promenade

Walk around your Corner, See Saw your partner Corner lady Swing, Allemande Left the next Pass the one you swung, Swing your partner, Promenade

MAVERICK WALTZ MIXER

Original Music: LS 3302 Medley, "Git Along Little Dogies" & "The Streets of Larado"

Formation: Double circle of couples facing couples with an inner circle facing outward and outer circle facing inward.

Measures:

- 1-4 Balance Forward; and Back; Slow Star Thru;;
- 5-16 Repeat 3 more times
- 17-20 Circle Left;;;;
- 21-24 Star Left
- 25-28 Half Promenade
- 29-30 Face those two, Inside couple Split Two;
- 3 1-32 Turn alone and take new girl.

Original Music: "Ten Pretty Girls" which is sprightly folk music. Try Molly Malone on Global 511 B. Formation: Any number of dancers side by side holding hands or arms around adjacent waist.

- 1-8 With Left Point Front, -, Point Side, -, Behind, Side, Close, -
- 9-16 With Right Point Front, -, Point Side, -, Behind, Side, Close, -
- 17-24 Forward four slow strutting steps (L, R, L, R)
- 25-32 Left heel forward & Lean Back, Left foot Back & Lean Forward, Stamp 3 times (L, R, L) Repeat starting with the other foot
