c) Publicity and Marketing:

- None of the topics listed in our last minutes were discussed in Ottawa.
- Various suggestions were discussed during the Publicity Round Table in Ottawa
 - Retention of dancers included suggestions for planning non-dancing socializing.
 - Beware of causing internal dissention.
- > Bob will send Publicity Group Meeting minutes to the Metro Representatives.

- Ended with the formation of a Society Publicity Group. Cathy Langille is the Coordinator of the National Marketing Team. (Quebec, Ontario, B. C., Alberta, Nova Scotia)

- Ask Cathy to send copies to Dottie on her e-mails since Dottie is working on this same recruiting issue as part of the Board of Governors of Callerlab.

- 50+ Expo was held on 13-14 June, 2014. We had demo dancers there on both Friday and Saturday performing in morning and afternoon. In spite of confusion regarding our planned dance area, we carved a space out for ourselves to dance and performed between other events. Some interest was expressed by some visitors in having a caller come to their organization, and we had a few participators from the audience.

- Dottie has created an updated list of clubs in the Metro Area that welcome beginning dancers for September 2014. The list includes Square, Round & Contra clubs and now says "ages 10 to 100".

- Dottie also has the open house list for SRDFNS as a word document. She will send both to Bob R.

- Contras have recently held introductory dancing in three areas:
 - Prospect in May prior to a regularly held jam session, (about 32 dancers, lots of musical talent)
 - Tantallon in August (about 70 people)
 - Wolfville last night (61 in attendance).

d) Metro Matters Editor, Dottie Welch:

e) Central Region Representative, Don Scott:

The SRDFNS AGM will be held at North Woodside on October 18, 2014.

SRDFNS Festival 2015: In an attempt to entice some attendees at the 64th US National in Springfield, Massachusetts into a Maritime vacation, the Federation has booked The Old Orchard Inn for July 10-11, 2015 and ANSSRDT will be coordinating our next Provincial Festival at that time.

f) DANS: The Interim Executive Director is Cliff La Jeune while Megan Metheson Hamilton is on maternity leave. Cathy Langille is an active member of the Board of Directors and thus is keeping the rest of the Board aware of the viewpoints and concerns of the square dance world.

g) Canadian Square and Round Dance Society: (from Bob and Inge Ruohoniemi)

- The AGM of the Society was held on July 18, 2014 in Ottawa

- Total Society membership for 2013-2014 was 10,362. (A decline of under 6% since previous year.)

- Membership in Nova Scotia was 1 Federation, 4 Associations, 27 clubs, 460 dancers.
- Membership fee for 2014-2015 is unchanged.

- The Articles of Continuance and the general operation By-laws under the Not For Profit Corporations Act, were approved. (Subsequently they were approved by Corporations Canada.)

- A motion to establish a system to include new dancers in the Society Liability Insurance for the period Sept to Dec was approved. (Not applying to snowbirds and dancers with the last 5 years.)

- A Publicity Round Table discussion was held during Festival 2014 in Ottawa. Various suggestions were made for promotion, recruitment, retention, and other special problems. A "Publicity Group" was formed with representatives from each province. Cathy Langille has volunteered as Coordinator for the National Marketing Team CSRDS.

- Attendance at the Ottawa National Festival was about 1060 dancers.

- In 2016 the next Canadian National Festival will be held in Regina, Saskatchewan, 28-30 July, 2016. They have a nice facility all inside the Delta Hotel. Full information including Registration Forms are available at www.saskfestival2016.com

h) In 2015 the 64th US National will be held in Springfield, Massachusetts June 24-27. This will be the first time it has been held in New England and as such is the closest it is likely to be in the near future. They are on track for at least 4000 dancers. Plan to be among them!

7. Club Reports

a) **Coordinators,** Dottie: Have just started dancing on Monday evenings at North Woodside CC (we had 2 squares in attendance).

b) **Lake City Swingers,** Dottie: Had three new dancers at our first open house. Hopefully we will have a few in class. Palma will be calling this week while Dottie is away teaching Northeast Callers School in New England. Swing Into Fall is on October 18, 2014.

c) Fun Squares: No report.

d) Harmony Squares: Dancing Sunday afternoons at North Woodside CC.

e) Tidal Waves: (Uncertain status because Bloomfield has been closed.)

f) **Parkland at the Lake,** Dottie: Due to begin dancing on the first and third Wednesday afternoons in November.

g) **Sail Sets,** Dottie: Dancing has just begun on Tuesday evenings at Grosvenor-Wentworth Park School. We will continue to dabble in C-1 (particularly in two-couple moves when we do not have a square.)

h) **Stardusters,** Ruby: Started with Kerry's annual potluck supper. Open house September 18 and 25. They have 4 returnees who will help with the class. Alan Parker has joined. He is square dancer from other places who studied in Nova Scotia and is now returning after working five years in Quebec. Also have 2 teenagers who are part of a family of new dancers. Class from 7-8:30. Club 8-10. Thursday had 2 squares dancing not including the class and others not yet present. Also have a full Executive. Preparing for 45th Anniversary in November. (The club started in September of 1965.)

i) Timberlea Twirlers: Report from Barry that they start dancing tomorrow.

j) Dancing Shadows, Dottie: Still attempting to dance when possible at the Crowe's home.

1) **Contra Time Dancers**, Dottie: We held our first dance on September 27. Next dance is November 1 at the Lutheran Church on Windsor Street. New dancers are always welcome.

m) **Halifax Contra Dancers**, Dottie: This group dances one Saturday evening per month at All Nations Reform Church on Windsor Street. They average 50 to 100 dancers (many 20-40 age group). Dances this fall are Sept. 20, Oct. 11, Nov. 15, and Dec. 6.

Country Dance and Song Society is celebrating 100 years. Halifax has been chosen to be a tour stop in their Centennial Tour. Square dancers are welcome at any of the planned events. Contra Time Dancers and Halifax Contra Dances are the coordinators under the auspices of Metro.
